## Frequently Given Responses Regarding the Exams

- ICAT only proctors the exams, providing a location, pencils or pens, and supervision. We cannot offer assistance regarding the content of the test. We do not grade the tests. We do not receive test scores.
- Exam scores are either sent to the e-mail address you have provided, or to your mailing address. Your score is also sent to your trainer.
- A score of 80 or above is considered passing.
- You have to show a photo identification card so we can determine that the correct person is taking the exam.
- Books, notebooks, purses, backpacks, cell phones and other such items are not allowed in the testing room.
- You can take a drink and/or a snack into the testing room.
- You cannot take notes during the test and we cannot let you copy the test.
